

Bag Pick-up (2nd Saturday):

When: Saturday, Nov 10th

Where: Parking lot of the Palm Bay Rec. Center (near Turkey Creek Library on Port Malabar Rd.) (Back-up location: St. Joes) **What time:** 10:00 am – until we are done (approx.: 1:00pm)

What to wear: Class A uniform

What to bring: Water bottle and snacks (rain gear if needed....we pick up bags regardless of the weather...there are many hungry people depending on us!)

Troop 520's assigned area: From Port Malabar, south to Malabar

Rd and from Babcock to US 1.

How it works:

- Only adult drivers over the age of 21 are allowed to drive during the event.
- Adult drivers will be paired with 2 or more youth (siblings are welcome to help too).
- Each team will be given a section of a neighborhood (maps will be provided).
- Once the team arrives at the proper location, the driver will turn on their flashers and proceed slowly down the street. Each adult will watch the child on their side of the car at all times always know where your child is!
- Look for bags of food....look carefully! They can be up near the door, on the patio, on a wall or near the road. Sometimes they are hard to see and sometimes there's more than one or a different bag is used.....look carefully! Some folks will wait for you and bring the bag out....always say thank you!
- When a bag is spotted, the driver will stop the car and the youth on that side of the car should go get the bag(s).
- Adults need to watch for cars! (Youth have their eyes on the bag and not on the traffic!)
- Youth are to stay on the driveways and sidewalks....do not cut thru yards are thru landscaped areas.
- Make it fun....it's like a treasure hunt!
- Big Smiles!! (remember "cheerful service")
- Do not enter a house and do not take anything offered....just say no thank you and go
 on to the next house.
- Once you have completed your assigned area or your vehicle is full, come back to base and unload and get a new location.
- We are done when the entire area is complete.
- After all areas are complete we will take to food (via the trailer) to the Wal-mart parking lot (on Malabar Rd) to the drop-off site where the food is unloaded and sorted by adult volunteers. Any and all are welcome to come and help.
